

## Bridge and Engine Leadership and Teamwork Refresher

### Course aim and objectives:

Ship-management is a highly demanding multi-tasked process requiring particular skills in addition to knowledge, experience and expertise. This course is based on IMO Model 1.39 and provides participants with a refresher of the leadership and teambuilding skills for controlling the operation of the ship and care for persons on board at the management and operational levels according to IMO STCW Amendments Tables: A-II/1, A-II/2, A-III/1, A-III/2 and A-III/6. By the end of the course participants should have sufficient knowledge, understanding and proficiency of leadership and teamworking skills to competently carry out their duties.

### Course main elements:

- Introduction to IMO STCW (as amended) seafarers' competence standards
- Shipboard personnel management and training
- International Maritime Conventions and recommendations
- Application of combined task and workload management
- Effective Resource Management
- Decision making techniques
- Practical exercises, case studies and final examination

### Course participation:

The course is open to Masters, Chief Engineers, Chief Mates, First and Second Engineer Officers, First and Second Deck Officers and ship officers who have sufficient familiarity with shipboard operations

### Course duration: 1 day

This training program is currently provided in 6-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 2 three-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions.
