

## Enclosed Space Operation and Hot Work

### Course aim and objectives:

This course provides participants with the required knowledge and understanding for performing enclosed space operations and hot work on-board and the risk controls that should be in place for performing safely such operations. Extensive reference is made throughout the course of the hazards and risks relevant to such operations, including the required permits to work and procedural compliance.

### Course main elements:

- Essentials to enclosed space and hot work operations
- Conditions, hazards and risk controls
- Procedural compliance and permits
- Requirements and standards
- Training needs - improvement of performance
- Reference to incident reports
- Practical examples and workshops

### Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company managers, operators, designated person(s), superintendents, masters and shipboard officers

### Course duration: 1 day
