

Emergency Preparedness and Response

Course aim and objectives:

This course provides participants with the required knowledge and understanding for handling incidents which if not properly observed may lead to an emergency in which planning and effective response is required as well as deploying and utilizing available resources and controls for mitigating the potential and consequences of such events as well as safety and environmental impact. In addition, the course familiarizes participants with the techniques and training required for effective response and control of all types of shipboard emergencies.

Course main elements:

- Ship-board risks and elements of crisis management
- Emergency organization and effective response planning
- Readiness and prevention
- Training and drills
- Training needs - improvement of performance
- Reference to past incident reports
- Practical examples and workshops

Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company managers, operators, designated person(s), superintendents, masters and shipboard officers as well as the emergency response office and shipboard team

Course duration: 2 days

This training program is currently provided in 12-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 3 four-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions.
