

STCW QUALITY STANDARDS FOR MARITIME TRAINING PROVIDERS

Course aim and objectives:

In 2010, IMO's STCW Convention was amended to standardize inconsistent training of seafarers and ensure competencies for all ship personnel. The STCW 2010 Amendments specify methodologies for the training and assessment of competence of seafarers as well as the qualifications of instructors and assessors including the quality standards required for maritime training organizations conducting instruction and assessment of competence to seafarers. This course familiarizes participants with the STCW required qualifications for instructors and assessors of competence of seafarers and the requirements for training organizations including the use of training equipment.

Course main elements:

- Review of STCW 2010 Manila Amendments
- Qualifications of instructors and assessors
- Quality standards for maritime training organizations
- Responsibilities of shipping companies
- Training and Certification amended requirements
- Implementation and Compliance
- Practical exercises and final examination

Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company quality and crew managers, superintendents conducting in-house training to crew members, maritime instructors and assessors, responsible persons of maritime training organizations, Master, Mates and Chief Engineers conducting on board familiarization training to seafarers.

Course duration: 1 day

This training program is currently provided in 6-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 2 three-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions.
