On-board Navigation Assessment and pre-Vetting Inspection

Scope of service: Real time navigational safety assessments are conducted on board as per OCIMF TMSA Element 5 and ISGOTT revised requirements ensuring effective and consistent application of navigational practices and bridge procedures in accordance with rules of the road and applicable industry standards. The service may take place either as stand-alone or combined with a pre-vetting inspection in accordance VIQ with a view to prepare the crew and vessel for an upcoming Vetting Inspection by Major Oil Companies and highlight areas requiring attention as well as best practices for promoting safety culture. The on-board navigation assessment may include type specific ECDIS training upon request as well as safety training for all crew members.

Criteria: The on-board assessment main criteria are:

- Navigational Safety & Bridge Procedures
- Passage Plan implementation - identification of best practices
- Record keeping and ship handling by the bridge team
- ECDIS type specific training
- Mooring operations and / or anchoring operations
- Safety and crew management with relevant document review
- Structural condition of the ship and pollution prevention
- Engine including steering compartment, cargo and ballast systems
- Ship's certificates and vessel overall appearance
- Safety culture on-board training

Outcome: At the end of the assessment, a detailed report is provided to the company identifying best practices noted and potential gaps requiring monitoring in accordance with regulatory requirements and applicable industry standards.
